ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS, PROHIBITING HUNTING AND PROHIBITING VEHICLES, INCLUDING MOTOR VEHICLES AND OFF ROAD VEHICLES, ON LANDS, TIDELANDS, SUBMERGED LANDS AND FILLED LANDS OF THE HUMBOLDT BAY HARBOR, RECREATION AND CONSERVATION DISTRICT LOCATED AT THE EASTERLY END OF PARK STREET, NORTH OF THE FOOT OF PARK STREET AND WEST OF FRESHWATER SLOUGH IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF HUMBOLDT COUNTY, NEAR EUREKA, CALIFORNIA CONTAINING 16 ACRES, MORE OR LESS

THE BOARD OF HARBOR COMMISSIONERS OF THE HUMBOLDT BAY HARBOR, RECREATION AND CONSERVATION DISTRICT, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. (a.) No person shall discharge a firearm of any description, rifles, shotguns, handguns, air rifles, spring guns, bows and arrows, slings or any other form of weapons, potentially harmful for wildlife and dangerous to human safety, on or upon any portion of the lands of the HUMBOLDT BAY HARBOR, RECREATION AND CONSERVATION DISTRICT, including, lands, tidelands, submerged lands and filled lands, located at the Easterly end of Park Street, North of the foot of Park Street and West of Freshwater Slough, in the unincorporated area of Humboldt County, near Eureka, California, containing l6 acres, more or less, more particularly described in the site location map shown in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated by reference as though set forth in full and legal description contained in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated by reference as though set forth in full.
- 1. (b.) No person shall hunt, molest, harm, kill, trap, chase, tease, shoot, discharge or throw any missile, bullet or arrow at any mammel, amphibian, reptile or bird on or upon any portion of the lands of the HUMBOLDT BAY HARBOR, RECREATION AND CONSERVATION DISTRICT, including, land, tidelands, submerged lands and filled lands, located at the Easterly end of Park Street, North of the foot of Park Street and West of Freshwater Slough, in the unincorporated area of Humboldt County, near Eureka, California, containing 16 acres, more or less, more particularly described in the site location map shown in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated by reference as though set forth in full and

legal description contained in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated by reference as though set forth in full.

- 1. (c.) No person shall operate, drive, possess, park or leave standing any vehicle, including but not limited to, two wheel and four wheel drive motor vehicles, automobiles, sand buggies, dune buggies, all-terrain vehicles, motorcycles, motor-driven cycles, motor-driven three-wheel cycles, motordriven four-wheel cycles, motor scooters, trail bikes, minibikes and bicycles on or upon any portion of the lands of the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District, including lands, tidelands, submerged lands and filled lands, located at the Easterly end of Park Street, North of the foot of Park Street and West of Freshwater Slough, in the unincorporated area of Humboldt County, near Eureka, California, containing 16 acres, more or less, more particularly described in site location map shown in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated by reference as though set forth in full and legal description contained in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated by reference as though set forth in full.
- 2. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by imprisonment in the County Jail not exceeding six (6) months or by fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both fine and imprisonment.
- 3. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date of its publication in The Times Standard newspaper, Eureka, California, pursuant to the provisions of Section 22, Appendix 2, of the Harbors and Navigations Code of the State of California.
